

SUSTAINABILITY

The Crystal is an all-electric building that uses solar power and a ground source heat pump to generate its own energy. It showcases state-of-the-art technologies to make buildings more efficient and also profiles Siemens' Environmental Portfolio. The building incorporates rainwater harvesting, black water treatment, solar heating and automated building management systems.





HOW IT WORKS



NATURAL LIGHT

Triple glazed windows allow in 70% of natural light... ...but only 30% of solar energy, ensuring the building doesn't overheat.



SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORT

2 minute walk from the DLR station.15 e-vehicle charging points.66 bike parking spaces.



WATER

Rainwater is collected from the roof and stored in a 30m³ under-ground storage tank.

80% of hot water is heated by solar thermal heating and ground source heat pumps.

100% of WC flushing water is taken from our non-potable sources.



ELECTRICITY

CO₂ emissions for the Siemens offices are 70% lower than in the average office building in London. 20% of electricity is produced by solar panels. The Crystal is a 100% electric building.


DIRECT SEAFOOD
